Dine at the beautiful Copper Beech Inn, whose building and grounds are also on this year's tour.

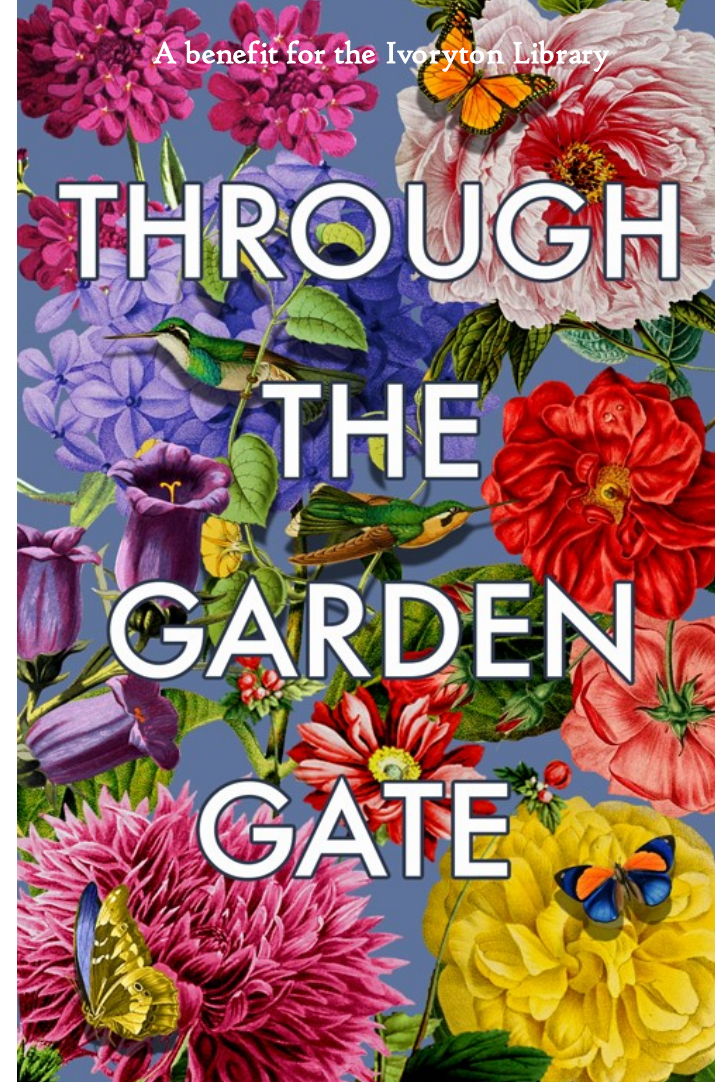

Through the Garden Gate

Saturday, June 15, 2019.

This walking tour of 8 lovely and unique homes and distinctive gardens shapes the charm of the villages of Centerbrook and Ivoryton. Each property holds its own story dating from recent construction back to the late nineteenth century.

The tour offers visitors a feel for the renewal of spring with the long-awaited blooms, colors, and beauty of summer gardens. As well as a glimpse into the gardeners' homes.

Leslie Barlow and Charlene Doane have done a wonderful job putting together this very special event.



The village of Ivoryton truly represents the Industrial Revolution as it was a community built around the ivory works factory of Comstock, Cheney & Company. You will notice the names of the homes along the tour that were once the homes to company executives and factory workers.

On our tour:

An **historic Victorian home** which is emblematic of the Industrial Revolution as well as a **Victorian farmhouse** which was more popular and is seen frequently throughout the Connecticut River valley.

Visit **Brookside Farm**: although the livestock is gone, there remain many gardens along the route of the Essex Steam Train.

A **converted carriage house** with a large perennial garden and vegetables has a lovely view of Falls River.

Several other very unique homes have been opened to display more of the history of this period as well as a newer house with **butterfly garden**.

Visitors can tour the gardens and enjoy lunch at the historic Copper Beech Inn which also has an English garden and fountain setting.
